St.John's Lutheran Medical/sick child Procedures

In the event that your child is ill or has a medical issue, we have a DOH nurse that will assist.

The nurse or teacher will call a guardian if warranted.

Situations that will require the child to go home

- 1. A fever of 99 or above
- 2. Respiratory issues/severe coughing
- 3. A rash of unknown origin
- 4. Vomiting
- 5. Intestinal issues(diarrhea)
- 6. Injury that requires medical attention
- 7. Child is severely uncomfortable or in pain
- 8. Head Lice
- 9. Ringworm

You may pick up your child at your own will however, the above ailments will **require** you to.

When do I need a doctor's note? Doctor's note must be the original. Students will not be permitted into the building without a doctor's note.

- 1. A child who has been out sick for three days or more will require a doctor's note to return to school.
- 2. A rash of unknown origin will require a doctor's note to return to school.
- 3. Respiratory issues will require a doctor's note.
- 4. An injury may require a doctor's note to return to school.
- 5. The nurse may request a doctor's note for students she feels require medical attention. This may include all of the above mentioned.

When does my child need to stay home/return to school?

- Fever- may return after they have been fever free(without medication) for 24 hours
- 2. Vomiting- may return after they are no longer vomiting for 24 hours.
- 3. Tested positive for COVID- May return after 5 days (symptom free)
- 4. When a child is generally not feeling well please keep them home.
- 5. Respiratory illness- May return after symptoms clear
- 6. Intestinal issues- 24 hours symptom free
- 7. Head Lice- Until all live Lice are gone
